

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi



This memorandum of understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between Okinawa National College of Technology (hereafter referred to as "ONCT") in Japan and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (hereafter referred to as "RMUTT") in Thailand. The two parties agree as follows:

PURPOSE

The primary objective of this MOU is to establish partnership and to develop cooperative efforts between Okinawa National College of Technology and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi in a wide range of educational collaborations. All activities conducted pursuant to the MOU shall be governed in accordance with the laws of Japan and the Kingdom of Thailand.

SCOPE OF COOPERATION

The areas of cooperation include, subject to mutual consent, various activities which ONCT and RMUTT deem desirable and feasible. Both partners will contribute to fostering and developing a cooperative relationship between the two universities.

AREAS OF COOPERATION

Cooperation shall be carried out, subject to the availability of funds and the approval of the president of ONCT and the president of RMUTT, or their representatives, through activities and programs such as:

- 1. Exchange and joint education of the students and other professionals;
- 2. Exchange of the faculty and administrators;
- 3. Exchange of science, technology information and academic resources that are of mutual interest;
- 4. Exchanges of information about the internship opportunities of university and research institutes;

5. Exchange lecture both on campus and long-distance media;

6. Conduct joint research and best practices in teaching;

7. Development of cooperation within programs;

The terms of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each specific program and activity that is implemented under the terms of this MOU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon, in writing, by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular program or activity and the terms of such program and activity shall be negotiated and agreed upon by representatives of the two universities.

RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving notice to the other party in writing by mutual consent or by six months' notice by either party. Failing such notice, the agreement will be renewed for like periods by tacit consent of the parties.

This MOU may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two parties. Such amendments, once approved by both universities, will become part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
