

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
SOUTHERN TAIWAN UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN
AND



RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI, THAILAND


This Memorandum of Understanding is made between the Southern Taiwan University and Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi; hereinafter, referred to as “STUT” and “RMUTT”.

1. STUT and RMUTT hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in the furtherance of the advancement of learning as stated below:
 - (a) To encourage visits by the faculty from either university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research;
 - (b) To facilitate the exchange of qualified students from either university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in undergraduate or graduate programs, and in the case of advanced graduate students, participating in research;
 - (c) To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and
 - (d) To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals.
2. Both universities acknowledge that the visit by the faculty and students from either university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of Taiwan and Thailand and shall comply with the regulations and policies of STUT and RMUTT.
3. Both universities agree that all expenses, including research material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs, shall be the responsibility of the participating scholars and determined on a case-by-case basis. However, each side will make its best efforts to make available university accommodation to the visiting faculty and students.
4. Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years following the date of signing, and acknowledge that this memorandum is subject to revision and termination at any time by mutual consent or by a 90 day written notice, by either party, prior to requested date of termination.

5. Both universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is incorporated into, and will provide the foundation and framework for, projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two universities and documented in other subsequent agreements.
