



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

between

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING, UNIVERSITAS GADJAH MADA, INDONESIA

and

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING, RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI, THAILAND

- Faculty of Engineering of Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi and Faculty of Engineering of Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM) wish to collaborate in order to benefit their research and teaching activities, and to further the internationalization of both faculties.
- The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) is to establish a
 framework within which co-operation may develop between the two institutions.
 This will occur within the context of the regulations and policies of each university
 and subject to the availability or resources.
- 3. Co-operation between the two faculties may include such activities as :
 - Exchanges of academic staffs
 - Exchanges of students
 - Full time graduate studies
 - Join research activities
 - Join community service program
 - Development of graduate level research training opportunities
 - Joint quality assurance and benchmarking

- Establishment of Joint Teaching Programs
- Such other projects for mutual benefit that are agreed upon by both parties.
- 4. Specific programs or activities will be undertaken under this MoA only after the written agreement of both faculties. The terms and conditions of the program or activity, including any financial arrangements, shall be set out in a written agreement signed by an authorized representative of each faculty.
- 5. Both parties shall designate a liaison office for this MoA and for any subordinate agreements under this MoA.
- 6. This MoA comes into effect when the last signatory signs. It will remain in effect for a period of 5 years from that date. Not less than six months prior to its expiry, the two faculties will review its operation and decide whether or not to renew it. Any such renewal shall be signed by an authorized representative of each faculty, and may include variations to this Memorandum.
- 7. This MoA may be terminated by the written mutual consent of both faculties, or by either faculty giving 60 days written notice to the other faculty.
- 8. This MoA places no financial or legal obligations on either of the faculties, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.
