



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING

YEUNG NAM UNIVERSITY

REPUBLIC OF KOREA

AND

THE FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY THANYABURI

THAILAND



In recognition of the mutual benefits derived from scholastic partnership, The College of Engineering, Yeungnam University (YU), Republic of Korea and The Faculty of Engineering, Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi (RMUTT), Thailand, agree to promote academic cooperation.

ARTICLE 1

The general purpose of this agreement is to establish specific educational relationships and linkage between the two participating universities in order to promote academic cooperation and partnership.

This MOU covers the following areas of cooperation under the two universities' respective academic procedures:

1. Exchange of staff, students and professors;
2. Joint research and development (R&D) and study visits;
3. Joint organization and conduct seminars, workshops, symposia and conferences;
4. Cooperation in providing degree and non-degree programs;

ARTICLE 2

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results achieved, as well as arrangements for visits, exchanges, and other executable forms of cooperation will be discussed further and developed mutually for each specific case. All financial arrangements will be discussed, depending on mutually agreed upon programs, projects and activities.

In order to carryout and fulfill the goals of this MOU, both parties will appoint Coordinators for the design, development and management of these joint activities. Through these Coordinators, as contact persons, either party may initiate proposals for activities under this agreement. Specific details will be set forth in a separate Letter of Agreement (LOA) which will stand as the executable terms of this general arrangement, subject to the approval by appropriate authorities for both parties, under normal procedures. An LOA will include such items as:

1. Scope of responsibilities of each institution for any joint undertaking
2. Schedule of implementation of any joint undertaking
3. Budgetary plans and sources of financing for any joint undertaking
4. Any other item deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity.

The coordinators will be further responsible for the evaluation of activities under this agreement, in accordance to the practices of the respective party.

This document is a statement of understanding and is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party.

ARTICLE 3

This MOU will take effect from the date of signing, for 5 years.

The understanding may be amended by mutual agreement.

Furthermore, this MOU may be terminated by either party at any time provided that the terminating party gives a minimum of six (6) months prior notice in writing.
